

MODE OF DELIVERY: DISTANCE LEARNING

The majority of Milpark Education's higher education qualifications are available in distance education mode. The focus of this approach is self-paced learning in a flexible, accessible format from anywhere in the world. Milpark uses its online learning platform, *myMilpark*, to lead students through their course material and to provide support.

What are the benefits of distance learning?

For many reasons, it is not always possible or feasible for students to attend classes on campus. Many students are employed and have families and some live far from the big centres. First and foremost, distance learning allows students to study from wherever they are, whenever it suits them. You will access study material, support material and assessments online on *myMilpark*. You will also have access to a study plan that will guide you through the semester and that will assist you with timing and planning your study activities.

There are two semesters per year for distance students and most part-time students complete two modules per semester.

Who should consider this option?

This mode of delivery makes it possible for students to obtain a degree from wherever they live or work, anywhere in the world, without attending classes at a campus. Furthermore, students who cannot or do not want to commit to weekly deliverables but who still want excellent support that will enable them to achieve a qualification, will find this option attractive. The fees for distance education are lower than those for contact learning or distance learning online.

What to expect from Milpark

Milpark offers a high-quality learning experience designed to enable you to achieve a degree that is relevant to the contemporary world.

On registration, Milpark study guides will become available online. On most modules, you will also receive your study guide in hard copy, delivered to you by courier service. In addition, you may be required to acquire a textbook. Additional study material in the form of videos and articles, for example, will all be available online.

Also online, you will find a study plan that will guide you through the semester, as well as Assessment Guidelines per module that indicate exactly how you will be assessed on that particular module. All critical dates, such as assignment hand-in dates, will be shown on a calendar. Formative assessments (with the exception of invigilated tests) are completed or uploaded online and detailed “How to” documents are available online to guide you through the processes. Feedback on formative assessments will be available online. Summative assessment takes the form of written, invigilated examinations – available at 40 venues countrywide.

Your lecturer will upload a past exam paper with suggested answers online and on some of the more challenging modules, additional practice questions will be uploaded. All students have access to Milpark’s Tutor line, which can be accessed via *myCourses* for content-related queries. Students will receive a response to their queries from the tutor within two business days.

Milpark offers a full online library service and students have access to online journal databases and an eBook library on *myCourses*. You can contact our librarian should you require any assistance.

Milpark also offers *live @Milpark* sessions on specified dates for many modules, where you can connect to a live classroom session presented by one of the lecturers. You can join the session from the convenience of your office or home. In addition, all sessions will be recorded, technology permitting.

The Student Support Department is available for all queries telephonically. Our dedicated Programme Manager is only an email or a phone call away to assist you with any other academic query or concern.

What Milpark expects from you

A stable internet connection is required to give you access to study material, assignments and discussions. The Milpark *myCourses* site can also be accessed via mobile devices.

While you can work through the study plan in your own time, it is important to take careful note of the assignment and online test dates, as these are non-negotiable. Other than these formal dates, you are free to structure your study plan as it suits your circumstances.

You are expected to follow the correct channels for queries, namely the Student Support Department for any administrative query relating to your registration, the tutor line for any content-related queries, and finally the Programme Manager for issues pertaining to module choice, exemptions, articulation, etc.

How will I be assessed?

Formative assessment consists of online tests and assignments uploaded online. All formative assessments contribute to your overall formative mark.

Summative assessment consists of a written, invigilated examination in most cases. The exception is some modules that have a final written report or dissertation that needs to be uploaded. Examinations are available at

any of our 40 examination venues countrywide. In limited instances, supplementary examinations also become available in the next semester.
