ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

Adult learners should be 21 years and older, and have:

- a General Education and Training Certificate (GETC); or
- a Grade 9 school report (or the old Standard 7), stating that they have passed Grade 9 or Standard 7; or
- a recognised equivalent qualification obtained at NQF Level 1 that requires two official languages; or
- an incomplete Senior Certificate qualification; or
- an incomplete National Senior Certificate (NSC) whose School-Based Assessment (SBA) validity has expired.

AN EXTRAORDINARY LIFE

IMPORTANT

- It is your responsibility to register with the Department of Education for your June exam session. This is a separate process from registering with Milpark for the tuition.
- Only in exceptional cases will out-of-school youth, who are between 18 and 21 years old, and who could not complete their school education due to circumstances beyond their control, be allowed to complete the Amended Senior Certificate (Adult Matric) course. These details must be verified by the Head of Department in their Provincial Education Department.
- Adult candidates, who are 21 years and older, with an incomplete NSC and whose School-Based Assessment component has not yet expired, may choose to complete the NSC, or convert to the Amended Senior Certificate (Adult Matric).

WHAT MILPARK EXPECTS FROM YOU

Connectivity

A stable internet connection is required to grant you access to study material, assignments and discussions. Note, however, that the Milpark myCourses site can also be accessed via mobile devices.

Study Plan

The study plan was designed to assist you in achieving your success, but it requires your focus and dedication. You will therefore need to do your part every week. MILPARK SUBJECTS

To pass the Amended Senior Certificate (Adult Matric), a candidate must have passed six (6) selected subjects, which are categorised as follows:

- Two (2) official languages, provided that one (1) of the two official languages is offered on the Home/First Language Level and the other one (1), on either the Home/First or First Additional/Second Language Level
- One of the abovementioned official languages must be a language of learning and teaching (LOLT) of institutions of further and higher education
- A minimum of four (4) other subjects must be selected; of the four (4) required subjects, a maximum of two (2) additional languages may be presented.

EXAMINATIONS

- Any student over the age of 21 wanting to sit the Department of Basic Education's (DoBE) June Amended Senior Certificate (Adult Matric) examination must register independently with the DoBE. Enrolment with Milpark College and registration to sit the examinations are therefore two separate processes.
- Milpark College will provide students with a guide on how to register with the DoBE for the external exams. However, it remains the responsibility of the student to register with the DoBE.

CERTIFICATION

Upon successful completion of the external Senior Certificate examinations for all six subjects, you will be issued with a Senior Certificate by Umalusi.

MODE OF DELIVERY

You will have the flexibility of studying from home, while having online support from your tutors. This mode of delivery makes it possible for students to study towards this qualification from wherever they live or work, anywhere in the country. Students who are interested in high-quality tuition, but who need flexibility in how and when they interact with fellow students, the tutor and the institution, will find this option very attractive.
